A young journalist for youthweek.eu

youthweek.eu is the website dedicated to the European Youth Week 2008 (EYW). It aims at promoting the EYW events, which are organised at a local, regional, national, or European level. One young journalist per country will be chosen to cover both the national and international events.

The journalist chosen will participate in a preparatory meeting in Brussels on September 18-19 and in the event itself on November 2-9, both in Luxembourg and in Brussels. A special programme will be organised for the journalists in Brussels where they will get the opportunity to follow the event, get in touch with the participants and meet and interview EU politicians and high officials.

The journalist should write at least three articles in English for the youthweek.eu website. One about the project chosen to represent the country, one about the activities organised during the week in the country and one about an event in particular. For every article published on youthweek.eu the journalist will receive 50 euros. The journalist will of course also produce material for his or her "home" medium or freelance independently. Texts written for youthweek.eu can be translated and used elsewhere, if the other party agrees to this.

We hope that you will be interested by this international opportunity and that you would like to join our European team of young writers.
